## HIGHLIGHTS SINCE 2014 TO DATE:

- More than 500 hundred people received donations from BVIF with the help of private and corporate companies since 2014.
- Approximately N\$300,000.00 worth of goods for example bicycles, medical equipment and other supplies have been distributed and donated to communities at large.
- Nearly 100 children received toys, clothes, shoes and blankets through our donation program initiatives.
